

What is 4-H Online?

4-H Online is the official Ohio 4-H Youth Development Program database for *enrolled* 4-H members and volunteers. This system is a partnership between the 4-H family and the county Extension office. Working together, we can guide you through any questions or problems to create a positive experience for all!

We are asking that all 4-H families re-enroll themselves into the 4-H Online system.

Please remember, this is NOT a database for counties/clubs/families to enter family members (i.e., siblings, grandparents, etc.) who are not directly involved as a 4-H member or volunteer.

New 4-H Families

- Please complete an enrollment form and the Extension staff will add you to 4-H Online. **DO NOT** create a profile in 4-H Online!

For Returning 4-H Families

- Check your email for your password information. If you did not receive an email, or need help with what email you registered with, please call our office for assistance. Do NOT establish another family or member profile if you were a member or volunteer before!
- Review your profile carefully. Any incorrect information can create problems for you, your family, and the Extension office.
- If your profile is not in 4-H Online and you have enrolled in the past, please contact the Extension office.

Quick and Easy Enrollment Steps

1. Go to oh.4honline.com – you may want to bookmark this page.
2. Follow “Returning Families” instructions. **DO NOT CLICK SUBMIT UNTIL YOU HAVE TRIPLE CHECKED YOUR PROJECT ENROLLMENTS.** Any project changes after submitting enrollment must be done by contacting the Extension office.
 - a. If you did not receive an email already, click “I Forgot My Password.” Enter your family email address. Role is “Family” and click “Send My Password.”
Note: *If your email is not in the system, please contact our office.*
 - b. Once receiving your email and temporary password, return to 4-H Online. Click “I Have a Profile,” enter in your email address and temporary password, set role to “Family” and click “Login.”
 - c. When you log in, you will be prompted to reset your password. Make your password easy to remember. Write it down, and store it in a safe place.
 - d. Once you are logged in, you will see the Family Member/Volunteer List. You will see the enrollment statuses are “Inactive.” Click “Edit” next to the person you wish to re-enroll for the current 4-H year.
 - e. If you don’t have an email address, contact the Extension office to be set up with a proxy email address.
3. At the bottom of the Personal Information Screen, click “Enroll for Upcoming 4-H Year.”



4. Update your 4-H record. You will work through updating/verifying the following items: Personal Information, Additional Information, Health Form, and Participating Information.
5. Click “Submit Enrollment.” The Tuscarawas County Extension staff will review all information submitted. The member will receive an email confirmation once membership approval is granted.

Repeat the above steps to re-enroll additional youth/volunteers in the household.

Parents – who are not volunteers – please do NOT create a profile.

Member/Volunteers will have until 11:59 PM on April 15, 2020, to enroll.

**Changes to non-livestock projects (after submitting enrollment)
can be done by contacting the Extension office before June 1.**
