To Our Returning and Prospective Buyers and Supporters:

We would like to extend an invitation to you to come to the Jr. Fair Small Animal Sale on Saturday, September 21 at 3:00 PM. The youth work hard to see that their project animal is properly cared for, well fed, and results in a desirable product. Your support of the sales is greatly appreciated by the Jr. Fair livestock exhibitors. If you choose to purchase a goat, you will be able to send it to the processor listed or donate the animal to local food banks in Tuscarawas County. If you purchase market poultry or market rabbits, they will be processed at a predetermined processor.

While we are still holding live auctions, Kaufman Realty is once again providing an online option for those who wish to bid and purchase from home or work. **If you plan to use the online bidding option, we encourage you to go to Kaufman-auctions.com in advance to register as an online buyer through their system.** Kaufman Realty has secured the URL **tuscountyjrfair.sale** to post the online auction catalogs. These catalogs will be active for bidding beginning 2 hours prior to the sale.

If you plan to attend the live auction and **DID NOT PURCHASE** an animal/product in 2023, **please provide your registration information at <http://go.osu.edu/TuscBuyerRegistration>.** This will minimize crowding and lines outside the arena prior to the sales. **If you PURCHASED** an animal/product in 2023, we are bringing your information over from last year as a courtesy for your support. You will just need to stop at registration prior to the sale to get your buyer's number and confirm that nothing has changed in your account.

Please note that if you register as an online buyer but end up coming to the live sale instead, you will need to re-register upon your arrival as there are two different computer systems being used for the online and live auctions.

What do 4-H Members do to get ready for the fair?

- **Attend 4-H Club meetings** through their local 4-H Club and complete a project book about their animal.
- **Quality Assurance** is a requirement from the Ohio Department of Agriculture for all of the market livestock projects. This consists of a one-hour training session involving OSU Extension personnel and community volunteers. Instruction includes good production practices, record keeping, animal health, and management issues.
- **Interview Judging & Skillathons** are attended by all members during July. The members are interviewed by volunteer judges and the members complete skillathon activities that test their project knowledge.
- **Showmanship** is a big part of showing off the hard work it takes to feed, care for, and groom an animal and be able to properly show it off to the judge. This is where the exhibitor shines in the show ring!

Small Animal Sale Committees Improvement Projects

Through the buyers' support over the past several years, many projects to improve Junior Fair have been completed. The following list shows you how your money has been put to use with the support of others.

- Fans for show arena and barns
- Education programs for youth
- Pens for livestock
- Fair building improvements
- Construction & expansion of multi-purpose pavilion

Ohio Department of Agriculture Regulations

All Grand and Reserve animals must be slaughtered. All market poultry are terminal and all entries must be slaughtered.

Payment for Purchases

Payment will be collected at the sales. Buyers may pay via cash, check, or credit card. It should be noted that a 4% fee will be charged if paying by credit card.

What can I do with the animals I purchase?

1. Goats may be sent to the following packers for processing to **your** freezer:
 - Baltic Meats (large livestock and goats);
 - Beitzel's Meats (large livestock and goats only);
 - Don's Custom Meats (large livestock and goats);
 - Sugar Valley Meats (large livestock and goats only);
 - Tilton's Custom Meats (large livestock and goats only).
2. Donate the animal to either the Sale Committee Improvement Fund or Tuscarawas County food banks; or
3. Goats may be sent to CYA Exchange (Carrollton Livestock Auction) for re-sale.
4. You may purchase goats or rabbits and handle all arrangements yourself.

All Poultry (turkeys, broilers, and ducks) will be slaughtered prior to the Small Animal Sale. A pick up date will be announced at the sale. While we will make an effort to return similar sized poultry, we cannot guarantee you will receive the exact birds that were purchased.

Transportation of Animals

The sale committees will arrange transportation to local packers and auctions free of charge. For transportation of sale animals, destinations need to be finalized at the time of the sale with **no changes after sales.**
