## Quality Assurance (QA)

- ◆ Get your QA requirement completed this day! Come at 2, 3, or 4 PM—attendance at only **one** time slot is necessary! (Members in Dairy projects can attend this day but a separate Dairy QA will be held in April.)
- ◆ Members 12 and older who have previously completed a QA—try the test-out option at 1 PM! If you pass, no other QA is required for the age-specified number of years (see QA brochure for specifics—[go.osu.edu/tusc4-hqa](https://go.osu.edu/tusc4-hqa))
- ◆ Two additional 2024 QA dates will be held but clinics will not be offered as a part of those QA opportunities.

## Beginner Clinics

- ◆ Learn about animal selection and care. Topics such as optimal purchase timing for fair, basic feed, pen size, etc., will be discussed in each species. This is highly recommended for beginners, but all are welcome! Clinics are optional and not required to meet your QA requirement. Parents are welcome and encouraged to attend!
