URGENT! Clover Café Help Needed!

The Clover Café is the Tuscarawas County 4-H Program's only fundraiser. Due to the revenue generated by the Clover Café, our county has not had to require county participation fees, additional project-based fees, or other county-wide fundraising events throughout the year. We challenge every club to send at least 5 people to work in the café at some point during fair week to ensure that our schedule is completely covered – this could be 4-H'ers, parents, advisors, friends of the 4-H program. This form specifies if members are exhibiting their project(s) and have completed club requirements to receive a fair wristband. These sheets determine wristband distribution and **need to be completed by 4 p.m. Monday, September 9**. The sooner the better! This allows us enough time to verify all members prior to wristband distribution.

Buyers Packets and Sale Information

Flyers and passes will be mailed to all 2023 buyers who purchased an animal/product at last year's sales. If packets were requested for a new buyer, those will also be mailed out. If you know of a potential new buyer, please stop into the Extension Office to pick up a packet for them **after September 4**; that will need to be hand delivered to the individual or business. We will not mail any additional packets at this point.

We will continue to use a hybrid format for the Market Livestock and Small Animal sales. The Market Livestock Sale will be on Thursday, September 19 with steers beginning at 12 noon followed by lambs and then hogs. The sale will run continuously; there will not be a set time for each species to begin selling. The Dairy Sale will be on Friday, September 20 at 3 p.m. The Small Animal Sale will be Saturday, September 21 beginning at 3 p.m.; sale order will be Broilers, Goats, Turkeys, Ducks, Rabbits.

Market Rabbit Tattooing

All market rabbit bunnies must be tattooed by a member of the Small Animal Committee. Tattooing will be held **Saturday, August 24 at 9-11 a.m.** at the Tuscarawas County Fairgrounds. If you are unable to make it to tattooing that day, you **MUST** contact Chris Kendle prior to Saturday to make alternative arrangements.

Pet Rabbit Show

Saturday, August 24 at 9 a.m. at the Main Arena at the Tuscarawas County Fairgrounds. There will be a Rabbit Dress Up Contest again this year and will begin once the Pet Rabbit Show is finished. Last year's contest was a lot of fun so make plans to stay and participate!

Dog Show

Saturday, August 24 at 9 a.m. at the Commercial Building at the Tuscarawas County Fairgrounds. In addition to obedience and showmanship classes, members can participate in rally, costume class, egg and spoon heeling, and the trick dog class.

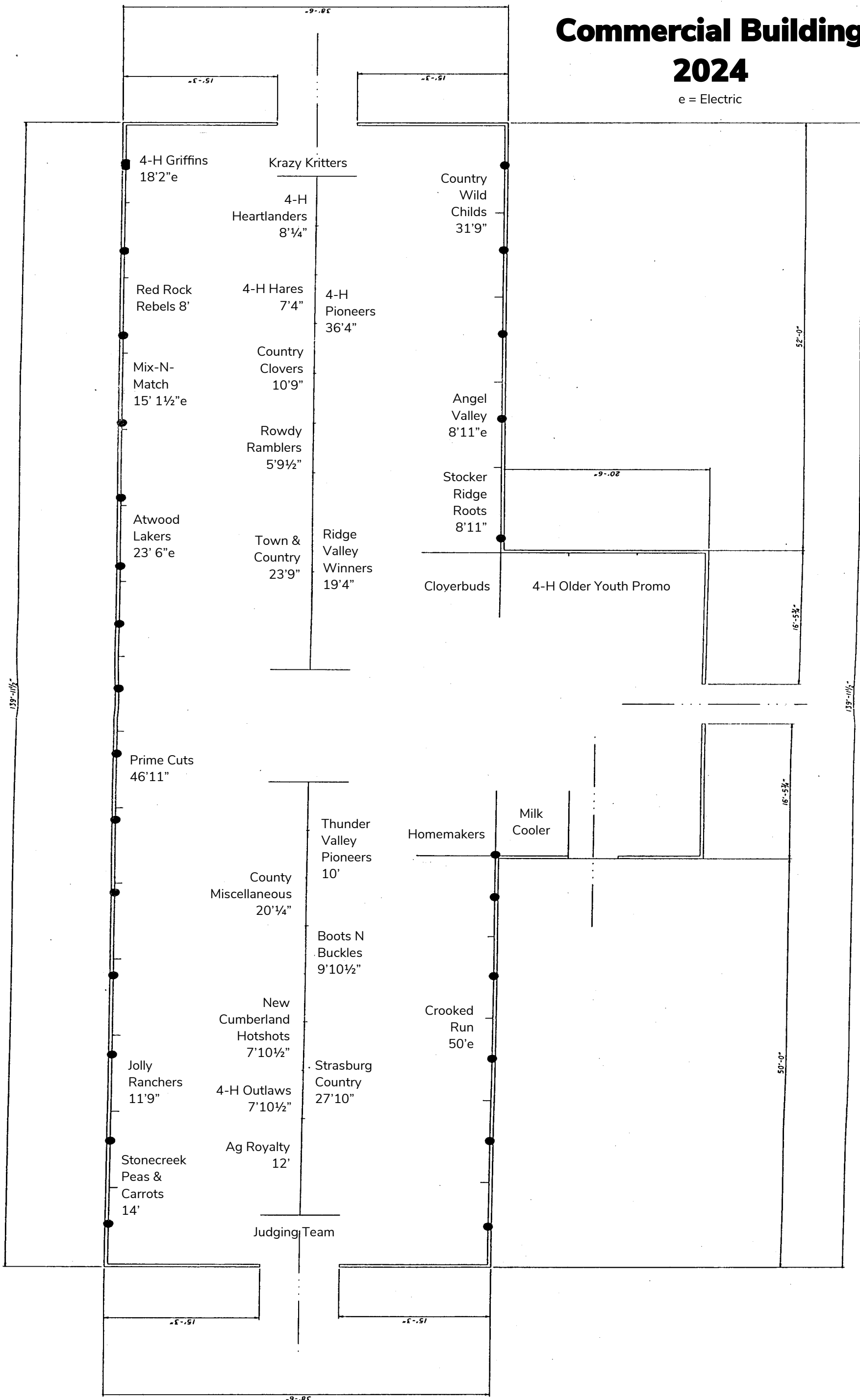
