Market Poultry Pick Up

Market ducks are scheduled to arrive Wednesday, July 24, and market chickens are scheduled to arrive on Wednesday, August 7. Members will be sent both an email and a text message confirming pick up dates and containing pick up information.

Make Up Livestock Judging Skillathons

Those who registered for Online Skillathon Judging should have received a link for their respective online skillathon on Monday, July 8 and a second reminder email on Monday, July 15. The email included details for completing the online skillathon and submitting project record books. If you registered for the online skillathon and have not received an email, please check your junk/spam folder for the link before contacting the office. **All online skillathon judging must be completed and all record books submitted to the Extension office by July 26.** Those with market chicken and market duck projects should complete the goals, learning experiences, leadership and citizenship, and quality assurance portions of the poultry record book. Graded record books can be picked up beginning August 12. **Members must have completed either in-person judging OR the online skillathon (with record books submitted to the office by the deadline) to be eligible to exhibit at the Tuscarawas County Fair.**

Cloverbud Camp

Calling all Cloverbuds! Fairgrounds Clean Up

If your club is interested in adopting a barn, arena, flowerbed, etc., at the fairgrounds and intends to schedule a clean-up event, please let us know! It is essential that we keep a list of who is doing what so we don't have clubs completing the same projects.

Stock The Trailer, Feed the Hungry

We are taking a new approach to our Stock the Trailer, Feed the Hungry campaign! This year clubs have the option to donate cans of food Saturday or Sunday during fair check in, OR to make a monetary donation which will be counted towards pounds of food, \$1 = 1 pound of food. Monetary donations can be made now through September 3. We will have prizes for the small club (15 members and under) and large club (16 members and over) with the most "pounds" of food contributed. Make checks payable to Tuscarawas County Junior Leaders.

Transportation List for Fair

We have been asked to compile a list of individuals who have trucks/trailers and are willing to assist members in safely/humanely hauling their animals to the Tuscarawas County Fair. If you or someone you know would like to be added to this list and help 4-H'ers safely deliver their animals to the fair (does not have to be a 4-H parent/advisor or even in this county), please email Chris Kendle (kendle.4@osu.edu) with name, phone number, and check in times you would be available to haul for (i.e. willing to haul for steer check in). You may request gas/mileage. The list will only be provided to those who contact our office inquiring about transportation to the fair.

Fair Entries – Super Important!!!

All fair entries must be submitted through the online entry system by 11:59 p.m. Wednesday, August 7, 2024. Note that a grace period will be extended from August 8 through 11:59 p.m. August 14, 2024; however, during this time entries will incur a \$100 per class fee. The fee must be paid before the entries will be approved in the FairEntry system.

Access FairEntry at <https://tuscjrfair.fairentry.com/>. You must log in using your 4-H Online username and password. Please contact Astra (armstrong.133@osu.edu) or Amy (vargo.201@osu.edu) if you need your 4-H Online log in information. The FairEntry system is linked to 4-H Online, so ALL YOUTH ALREADY HAVE FAIRENTRY PROFILES. Do NOT create a “new” exhibitor! Doing so may prevent us from being able to properly include you in show/sale bills, stalling assignment lists, etc.

A few reminders regarding your fair entries:

- For animals with 4-H Online registrations, all tag numbers and animal information will be pulled over into the FairEntry system. Please check that the tag number is correct for the animal you are selecting. If you are taking a family market back-up that was not registered to the member (i.e., a sibling’s back-up animal), please contact [Chris](#), [Michelle](#), or [Renée](#).
- Those with market beef (steers or market heifers), market poultry, and market rabbits, you will need to select the “add an animal” option to complete your entry.
- Remember youth MUST **register for SHOWMANSHIP** when making their entries. Members may decide to drop showmanship without penalty, but no showmanship entries will be taken after the deadline.
- Beef exhibitors: if you are planning to exhibit in **Bred, Born and Raised**, that must be included on your entry as well.

Buyer’s Board Photos


- Those exhibiting **market beef, sheep, goats, and hogs** will need to **include the picture** for the buyer’s boards at the time you complete your fair entry. They must be in a **landscape (horizontal) format**.
- For those exhibiting **market rabbits, market turkeys, market chickens, and/or market ducks**, your pictures are due by September 1 and should be emailed to tuscjrfair@gmail.com
- Unusable photos will be sent back to you. This includes photos taken vertically/portrait view, photos with unacceptable backgrounds, and/or dirty animals. A new photo must be resubmitted by the entry deadline. A 4-H clover or FFA emblem (whichever is appropriate for the project entry) will be used if a new, usable photo is not received by the deadline.

Updating/Editing Fair Entries

Your fair entries may be edited up until 11:59 p.m. on August 7. To edit your entry, wait until you have received your entry confirmation and approval. This will come to the email you have on file in the 4-H Online/FairEntry system. Once you have received this confirmation/approval, you will be able to go *back into* the FairEntry program and make changes. All additions/changes will need to be approved to be finalized.

OSU Extension staff are unable to make changes to fair entries over the phone. All changes must be requested in writing with requests received prior to the August 7 deadline. You can email requests to tuscjrfair@gmail.com. You will receive an email confirmation of changes from the FairEntry system.
