Wristband Distribution

Members/advisors/committee members may pick up their wristbands at the Clover Café during the following times:

- Friday, September 13, 3 - 5 PM
- Saturday, September 14, 10 AM - 2 PM
- Sunday, September 15, Noon - 5 PM

Parking Passes

TMK has generously sponsored **one fair parking pass per family** again this year (only families with horses or livestock at the fair). These passes can be picked up during wristband distribution. Individuals wishing to purchase an additional parking pass (one additional pass per family) may do so at the Senior Fair Board for \$20. DUNF's

Exhibitors with **market animals or animals in lactation (during exhibition)** are required by the Ohio Department of Agriculture to fill out a Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF). DUNF's will be online *only*. Due to stricter regulations now in place regarding completion of the DUNF, we are no longer able to correct/update forms once they have been submitted. **We STRONGLY encourage you to wait until the morning of check-in or until you have reached the fairgrounds to complete the form.** We will have iPads available at the fair for you to use to complete the DUNF. Animal Check-Ins

All animals must check-in during their assigned times. No exceptions. Members do not have to be with the animal during check-in (a sibling, parent, advisor, friend, etc. can bring the animal to check-in if needed). Two Sale Maximum

Per rule #30 on page 48, members are only eligible to receive money from the sale and/or shares associated with two revenue generating exhibits, regardless of the number shown. Those with 3 or more revenue generating exhibits must declare which two sales they wish to receive proceeds from 24 hours prior to the first sale.

Pen Assignments

Pen assignments will be posted by Wednesday evening (9/11/24) (possible exception rabbit and poultry pens). You may start decorating your pens and fair booths once they are posted. Please make sure you are at the correct pen (note: hog, goat, and sheep pens are numbered). If you decorate the wrong pens/area, your decorations will be taken down and held at the Junior Fair Board Office for someone in your club to pick up.

Fair Booths

If your club is decorating a fair booth, please review the booth decoration information sheets at <https://tuscarawas.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/tuscarawas-county-junior-fair#4-H%20Fair%20Booths>. These sheets include information about materials that are permitted/not allowed by order of the Fire Marshall. It is essential that all guidelines be followed. Also, keep in mind that **NO ADHESIVES or STAPLE GUN STAPLES** may be used in fair booths. We highly recommend placing items in the Commercial Building up off the floor as the building is prone to flooding if we get even the slightest rain.

Kiddie Showmanship

Youth who are at **least 5 years of age by the day of show but not of age to exhibit at the fair** may participate in **up to 2 Kiddie Showmanship classes** during the fair. Forms may be submitted at the **Junior Fair Board Office beginning Saturday, September 14. Entries must be received by the start of showmanship for the given species** (i.e., hog kiddie showmanship entries must be submitted at the Junior Fair Board Office by 9 a.m. on Tuesday, September 17).
